| 5. avoid | sakınmak | The suspect avoided talking to the police. |
| 6. can't help | knd.ni yapmaktan alıkoymamak | I can't help thinking about the past. |
| 7. can't stand* | katlanamamak(can't bear) | Lily can't stand working in a smoky atmosphere. |
| 8. complete | tamamlamak | Tom finally completed writing his term paper. |

| 14. detest | nefret etmek | He detests starting the day with an argument. |

| 16. dislike* | hoşlanmamak | He dislikes being the focus of attention. |
| 17. enjoy | hoşlanmak | I enjoy playing chess. |
| 18. excuse☛ | mazur görmek, affetmek | The teacher won't excuse your coming late again. |
| 19. finish | bitirmek | They finished studying at ten sharp. |

| 22. imagine | hayal etmek | I just can't imagine having to spend the rest of my life in jail. |
